

Summary of CV

Dr. Ying Fang is a distinguished professor at Department of Pathobiology at University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. She is an elected Fellow of the National Academy of Inventors. Dr. Fang obtained her PhD degree in microbiology in December 2004 from South Dakota State University. She was appointed as Assistant Professor at the same University in January 2005 and promoted to Associate Professor in 2011. In 2013, Dr. Fang moved to Kansas State University, served as Associate Professor and was promoted to Full Professor in 2016. In 2019, Prof. Fang joined the University of Illinois as a Full Professor. In 2025, she was named as Distinguished Professor in Diagnostic Test and Vaccine Development.
