Giovanni Trevisan holds an Assistant Professor position at Iowa State University. Dr. Trevisan earned his DVM degree in Brazil and worked as a practitioner for eight years at JBS swine business before moving to the US to pursue a PhD in Population Sciences in Animal Health at Iowa State University. Currently, Dr. Trevisan serves as a co-PI on the Swine Disease Reporting System and is engaged in teaching, research, the FieldEpi team, and ISU VDL-related work. Dr. Trevisan's research work covers epidemiological tools and concepts for early detection of emerging or re-emerging animal health threats and the generation of epidemiological information to support producers and veterinarians in making informed decisions for disease surveillance, monitoring, prevention, and control. Applied inter and intra-veterinary diagnostic database handling and connectivity concepts to collate, analyze, model, and interpret diagnostic data for epidemiological usage and applications.
